

International Business Profile

A Level study at Friedrich-List-Schule Mannheim (FLS) is open for everybody intending to achieve full A Level (i. e. Abitur) at an entrepreneurial college (i. e. Wirtschaftsgymnasium) within three years. It is especially appropriate for students who are interested in business administration and economics in a bilingual context (English/German). Content and language integrated learning (CLIL) is a very important tool for life-long learning in a globalised world.

Entry requirements

- **(Werk-) Realschulabschluss/Fachschulreife (i. e. GCSEs)**
In your final exam you need to have an average of German, English and Mathematics of at least grade 3.0 and in each of these subjects at least grade 4.0 or
- **Gymnasiasten (i. e. grammar or comprehensive school pupils)**
Certificate of moving up (i. e. Versetzungszeugnis eines Gymnasiums) which entitles you to attend an initial course of an entrepreneurial college.

Certificates and entitlements

- You can achieve a crucial part of a leaving certificate entitling you to study at a polytechnic after two years (i. e. Fachhochschulreife) or you can achieve full A Level after three years (i. e. Abitur).
- Full A Level will entitle you to enrol at any university or college and also for any subject. If you are not interested in studying you will achieve competences which will help you to pursue a career in business management and administration. Moreover there is a possibility to shorten the time for a traineeship or on-the-job training.

Additional opportunities

Numerous additional opportunities contribute to your personal development and to your holistic education, e. g.

- Exchange programme with our partner school in Smederevo/Serbia
- Excursions, company tours, presentations, co-operations with local and regional companies (Tyzkca, DB Schenker, SAP)

- **Registration**
At school secretary until 1st of March.
- **Documents**
Filled in registration form, certified copies of end-of-term report/-certificate and/or certificate of final exam (if already available).
- **Presentation**
Every last Saturday in January we will open our gates to inform you about our goals and about our organisation concerning A Level study.
